1. BRIEF BACKGROUND:

M/s Rajasthan Small Industries Corporation Ltd. (RSICL) was incorporated as a "Private Limited Company" under the Indian Companies Act 1956 on 3rd June 1961 and became a "Public Limited Company" w.e.f. 01.02.1975. RSICL is a Government of Rajasthan Undertaking and is the custodian for parcels being cleared through Air Cargo Complex since 1979 as well as parcels imported/exported as personal carriage by passengers through Jaipur Airport since 2004. The Authority, vide its Multi Year Tariff Order (MYTO) No. 19/2013-14 dated 24.05.2013 decided that the cargo facility services provided by RSICL is "not material", hence "light touch approach" be adopted for determination of tariff for the 1st Control period. Further, the Authority approved the tariffs as were existing on 31.03.2011 for the period 01.04.2011 to 31.03.2016.

1.1 The Authority allowed RSICL to continue the levy of tariffs existing as on 31.03.2016 up to 31.03.2019 from time to time vide following interim Orders:

- i) Order No.11/2016-17 dated 29.09.2016 up to 31.03.2017;
- ii) Order no.19/2016-17 dated 31.03.2017 up to 30.09.2017;
- iii) Order no.12/2017-18 dated 29.09.2017 up to 31.03.2018;
- iv) Order no.43/2017-18 dated 28.03.2017 up to 30.09.2018;
- v) Order no.21/2018-19 dated 28.09.2018 up to 31.03.2019;

2. MYTP/ATP SUBMISSIONS MADE FOR SECOND CONTROL PERIOD:

RSICL, have submitted their Multi Year Tariff Proposal (MYTP) on line on 30.01.2018 in respect of the cargo facility services being provided at Jaipur Airport in respect of the 2nd Control Period of 5 years commencing w.e.f. 01.04.2016 to 31.03.2021 as prescribed in Chapter II of the Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India (Terms and conditions for determination of tariff for services provided for Cargo Facility, Ground Handling and Supply of Fuel to the Aircraft) Guidelines, 2011 (the Guidelines).

3. PRINCIPLE FOR DERTERMINATION OF AERONAUTICAL TARIFF :

As stipulated in the Guidelines, the Authority shall follow a three stage process for determining its approach to the regulation of a regulated service:-

- (i) Materiality Assessment;
- Competition Assessment: (ii)
- Assessment of reasonableness of the User Agreements between the service (iii) providers and the users of the regulated services.

4. AUTHORITY'S EXAMINATION OF THE PROPOSAL

- 4.1 In respect of the regulated service(s) provided for the cargo facility at the airport, the Authority considers that materiality of the service is linked to the cargo volume at the major airport. The percentage share of cargo volume for Jaipur Airport (as per AAI statistics for FY 2014-15), is 0.13% which is less than 2.5% Materiality Index fixed for the subject service. Hence the regulated service is deemed **'not material'**.
- 4.2 In the instant case, the regulated service being provided by RSICL at Air Cargo Complex, Jaipur Airport, is **'not material'** hence, the Authority, decided that in accordance with the provisions of AERA Guidelines the tariff will be determined under **"Light Touch Approach"** for the 2nd Second Control Period.
- 4.3 The Authority, noted that RSICL have submitted all Forms as required under the MYTP. However, as the subject service is deemed 'not material' and will come under the 'light touch approach' for tariff determination, only the completeness in respect of the information submitted has been assessed by the Authority. RSICL has submitted the ACS for FY 2012-13 to FY 2016-17.

The Authority, further noted that, under the MYTP for 2nd Control Period, RSICL have not sought any revision in the tariff for the cargo facility at the Air Cargo Terminal, Jaipur Airport, Jaipur, from the level as was existing as on 31.03.2016.

The Authority, also noted that the 'Space Licence Fee Agreement' of RSICL with Airport Operator, Airports Authority of India, Jaipur Airport (valid for 10 years) is ending on 31.03.2019.

4.4 The Consultation Paper No. 22/2018-19 dated 25.10.2018 was put on AERA's official website. Till date no comments/views have been received from any stakeholders. Hence, the Authority, presumes that the stakeholders have no objection to the proposal.

ORDER

- 5. Upon careful consideration of material available on record, as well as submissions made by RSICL, the Authority, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 13(1) (a) of the AERA Act, 2008 hereby orders that:
 - (i) The cargo service being rendered by RSICL at Jaipur Airport is 'not material'. Hence, the Authority, will adopt a 'Light Touch Approach' for determination of tariff for the 2nd Control Period w.e.f. 01.04.2016 to 31.03.2021.

(ii) The Authority, decides that RSICL, may be allowed to continue with the tariff as was existing as on 31.03.2016 (Annexure-I) up to the period ending 31.03.2019. The Authority, further decides that, if the Space Licence Fee Agreement of RSICL with Airports Authority of India, Jaipur Airport, is renewed beyond 31.03.2019, then RSICL is allowed to continue the same tariff for the residual years of the 2nd Control Period, i.e. up to 31.03.2021, otherwise this order will cease to be in operation from the date of termination of the 'Space Licence Fee Agreement' of RSICL at Jaipur Airport.

The Concession Agreement of CSC for Courier Cargo Services at Mumbai airport is valid only till 31.07.2021.

2. The Authority is in receipt of MYTP/ATP submissions for the 3rd Control Period (FY 2021-26) from some of the Independent Service Providers for Fuel Farm/ITP services. These proposals are currently under scrutiny and Consultation Papers will be issued shortly. Further, MYTP/ATP submissions for the 3rd Control Period (FY 2021-26) in respect of Cargo Handling / Ground Handling services have not been received from many ISPs.

Considering the above, the Authority, expects that the tariff determination process for the aforesaid service providers is likely to take some time. Hence, in the interim, the Authority, has decided that the Independent Services Providers as per above list,

except M/s CSC, Mumbai (at s.no.22 in the list), may be allowed to continue the levy of the existing tariffs, applicable as on 31.03.2021, for a further period of six (06) months w.e.f. 01.04.2021 to 30.09.2021 or till determination of tariff(s) whichever is earlier.

In the case of M/s CSC, Mumbai (at s.no.22 in the list), providing Courier Cargo Services at Mumbai Airport, the Authority observed that their Concession Agreement with the Airport Operator MIAL is valid only till 31.07.2021. Accordingly, the Authority, has decided that M/s CSC, Mumbai, may be allowed to continue the levy of the existing tariffs, applicable as on 31.03.2021, for a further period of four (04) months w.e.f. 01.04.2021 to 31.07.2021 or till determination of tariff(s) whichever is earlier.

ORDER

3. In view of the above, to avoid any regulatory vacuum in respect of the tariffs being levied by the regulated entities, the Authority, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 13(1) of the Airport Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008 hereby orders that:-

- (i) The Independent Service Providers as per above list (SI. No. 1 to 57 of table except M/s CSC, Mumbai listed at s.no. 22) are allowed to continue levy of existing tariff, applicable as on 31.03.2021, for a further period of six (06) months w.e.f. 01.04.2021 to 30.09.2021 or till determination of tariff by AERA for the relevant control period (for 2nd /3rd Control Period, as applicable) whichever is earlier.
- (ii) M/s Cargo Service Centre (CSC), Mumbai, is allowed to continue the levy of the existing tariff, applicable as on 31.03.2021, for a further period of four (04) months w.e.f. 01.04.2021 to 31.07.2021 or till determination of tariff for 3rd Control Period whichever is earlier.
- (iii) The Airport Operators may ensure timely submission of proposals by Independent Service Providers at the respective 'major' airports and also ensure compliance of the Order.



Hence, in the interim, the Authority, has decided that the Independent Service Providers / Airport Operators as per above table, except M/s Concor Air Ltd. (at s.no.16 in the list), may be allowed to continue the levy of the existing tariffs, applicable as on 30.09.2022, for a further period of six (06) months w.e.f. 01.10.2022 to 31.03.2023, or, till the determination of regular Tariffs by AERA for their respective control periods, whichever is earlier.

In the case of M/s Concor Air Ltd. (at s.no.16 in the list) providing Domestic Cargo Services at Mumbai Airport, the Authority notes that their Concession Agreement with the Airport Operator MIAL is valid only till 31.12.2022. The Authority is in receipt of MYTP/ATP submissions from some of the Independent Service Providers/ Airport Operators in respect of services relating to Cargo handling, Ground Handling & Supply of Fuel to the Aircrafts. These proposals are currently under various stages of tariff determination process. However, MYTPs from some ISPs/ AOs are yet to be received.

4. Considering the above, the Authority, expects that the tariff determination process for the aforesaid service providers will take some time.
